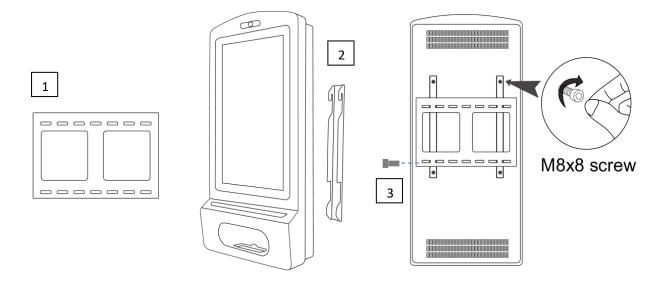

## Steps for Mounting - Wall Mounted

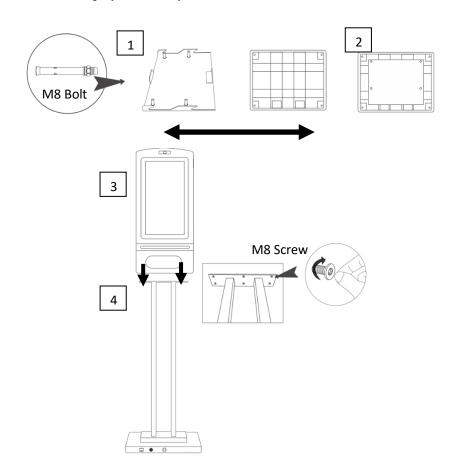
- 1. Securely fix the wall bracket onto the back of the screen.
- 2. Using two people, lift the display onto the bracket.
- 3. Screw the small fixing screw into the side of the bracket to lock the screen in place.





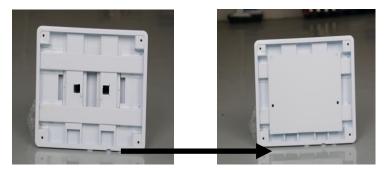
## Steps for Mounting - Freestanding

- 1. Place the floor plate in location and bolt to the floor using M8 Bolts.
- 2. Slide Floor stand onto floor plate and screw in place
- 3. Using two people, carefully lift the display onto the floor stand
- 4. Use M8 screws to secure the frame into the bottom of the screen.
- 5. Lock Stand to Base tightly with the key

# USING THE DISPLAY FOR THE FIRST TIME

#### **Screen Checks**

### 1. Power on the display and check volume indicator

Power on the display. The sanitizer volume indicator should display as red.



## 2. Checking Dispenser Border Light

The dispenser border light should display as blue when not in use. Place your hand in the dispenser to activate the sensor. A click should be heard and the border light should change to green.





### 3. Deciding what type of Sanitizer you wish to use

Before use, please decide whether Liquid or Gel Sanitizer will be used.

#### 4. Opening the unit

Use the keys provided to open the two locks on the side of the unit and carefully open the display









# 5. Liquid Sanitizer

If you are using liquid sanitizer, ensure that the button highlighted below is pressed **IN**.





Ensure the following dispenser head is being used for Liquid Sanitizer:



### 6. Gel Sanitizer

If you are using Gel sanitizer, ensure that the button highlighted below is pressed **OUT**.





Ensure the following dispenser head is being used for **Gel Sanitizer**:



**NOTE** – to change the dispenser, simply unscrew and replace.



# 7. Pour in your Sanitizer

Unscrew the blue cap and carefully pour in your required sanitizer.









# **REMOTE CONTROL**





1. Power off button



2. Press this button to return to Home screen



3. Press MENU to organize screen and apps



4. Mute.



5. Move selection Up



6. Move Selection Down



7. Move selection Left



8. Move selection Right



9. Enter – press to confirm selection



10. Volume up



11. Volume Down



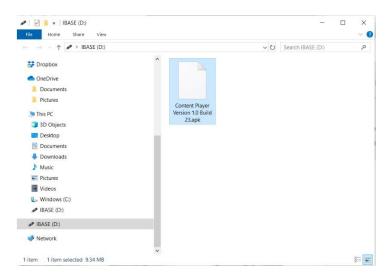
12. Exit – Press to return to previous page.

#### INSTALLING/UPDATING THE TOPAZ CONTENT PLAYER SOFTWARE

- 1. Request the latest APK installation file from TOPAZ Digital or your reseller.
- 2. On your computer, copy the APK file onto a blank USB memory stick. Once copied, safely remove the USB from your computer.



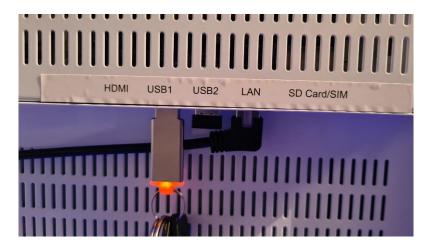
- 3. Turn on the Hand Sanitizer Display
- 4. Use the keys provided to open the two locks on the side of the unit and carefully open the display







5. Insert the USB memory stick into USB Port 1 and a USB mouse into USB Port 2.

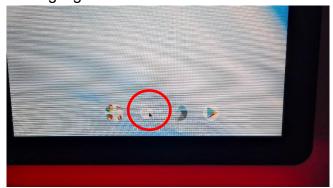




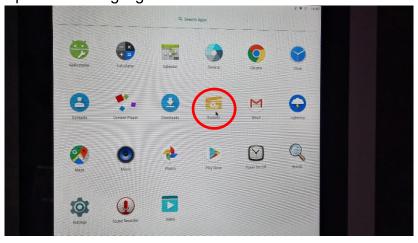
6. A pop up will appear in the middle of the screen and the black Android navigation bar will appear at the bottom of the display. Click the white circle in the centre of the bottom black bar (circled beow)



7. Select the white circle highlighted below

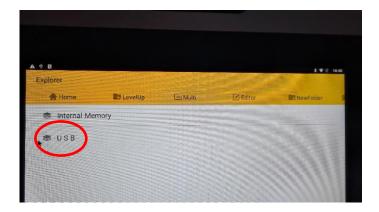


8. Select the 'Explorer' icon highlighted below

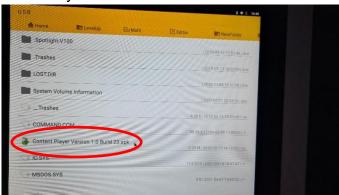




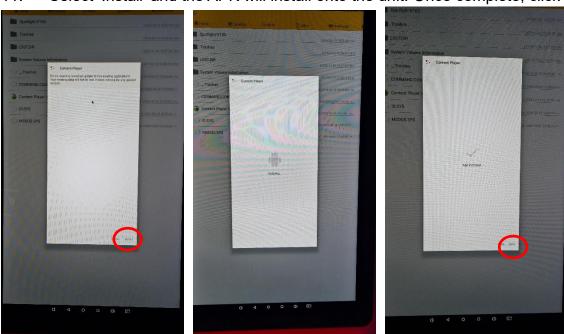
## 9. Select USB



10. Select the Content Player APK file saved on the USB



11. Select 'Install' and the APK will install onto the unit. Once complete, click Open



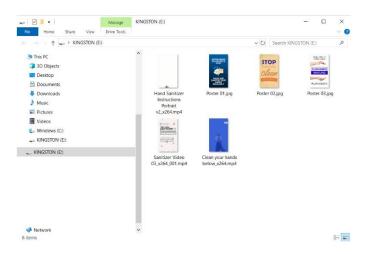
12. The Content will now begin to play and the software has been successfully installed.



#### **UPDATING THE DISPLAY VIA USB**

Your TOPAZ Hand Sanitizer Display will come with the TOPAZ Content Player Software pre-installed. However, this may need updating/reinstalling. Please follow the guide below on how to do this.

13. On your computer, copy your content (jpgs and/or videos as above) onto a blank USB memory stick. Once copied, safely remove the USB from your computer.



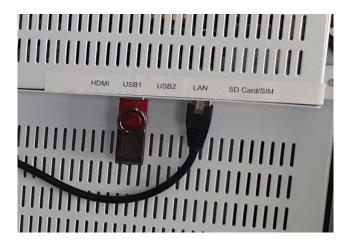
14. Use the keys provided to open the two locks on the side of the unit and carefully open the display





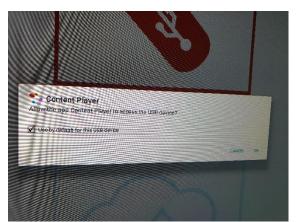


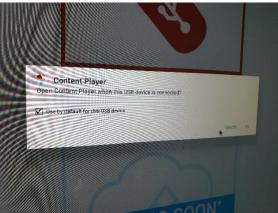
15. Insert the USB into USB Port 1. The content will update on the display.





16. When the first pop up message appears, use a USB mouse to click the checkbox 'Use by default for this USB device?' and click OK (a USB mouse can be inserted into USB2).





**NOTE** – This only needs to be done once for a particular USB memory stick. When content is updated in the future using the same USB memory stick is used, it will automatically update

17. Your content will now update. Ensure all content is playing and remove the USB stick.



### CONNECTING THE DISPLAY TO THE TOPAZ CLOUD CONTENT PLAYER (PLATINUM PACKAGE)

If you have a Platinum Package subscription, you will have received login details for the TOPAZ Content Player CMS and screen License and Serial Information. Please have this information to hand and follow the instructions below to connect the display to the Cloud Content player CMS.

### NOTE - Ensure your screen is connected to the internet via LAN or WiFi

1. Insert a USB mouse into the USB port on the display and turn the display on.



2. When the screen has booted up and content starts playing, click the left mouse button on the centre of the content.

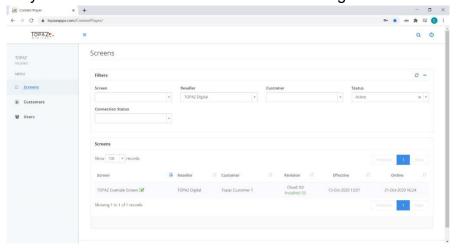


3. A screen will appear asking for the License Key and Serial Number. Enter this information and click 'Register'. (note – connecting a USB keyboard to the screen will speed up the input of this information).





4. Login to your Content Player Cloud account and click on 'Screens'. Next to the screen name there should be a green 'tick'. This means that the screen has been successfully linked to the internet and is communicating with the server.



5. If there is an orange 'cross', either the Serial/License info has been input incorrectly or the screen does not have internet access.

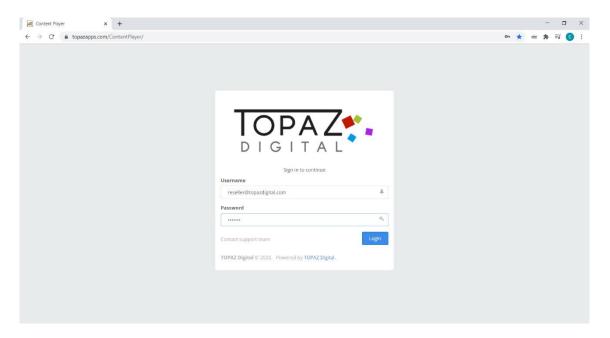

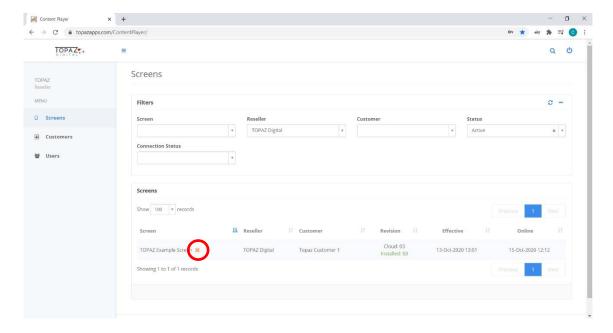
#### Logging In

Once your display(s) have been registered for the Platinum package, you will receive your login details which will allow you to manage your display(s) via the Cloud. Below is how to manage your account as a Reseller

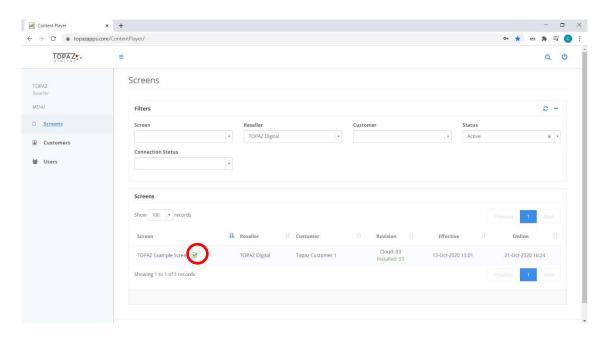


2. Once logged into your account, you will see the 'Screens' section. This will show all screens assigned to your reseller account by TOPAZ. In the demo screen below, you can see an orange cross by the screen name (circled below). This means that your screen is currently offline.



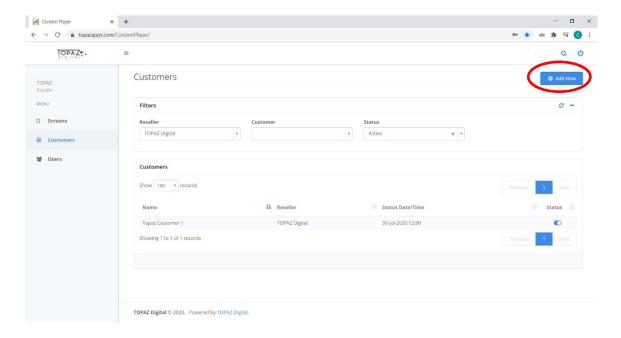


3. Once your screen is connected to the internet, this will change to a green tick (see below). Your screen cannot be updated via the cloud unless it is online.



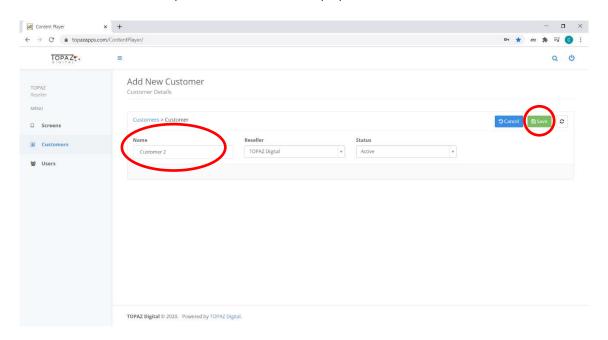
#### **Creating and Managing Customers**

- 4. As a reseller, when you have sold a screen to a new customer, you will need to create a new Customer Organization. This will then allow you assign screens and user logins to this organization.
  - Click on 'Customers' on the left side menu and this will display a list of your current customer organizations. To manage an existing organization click on the name, to create a new one click 'Add New'

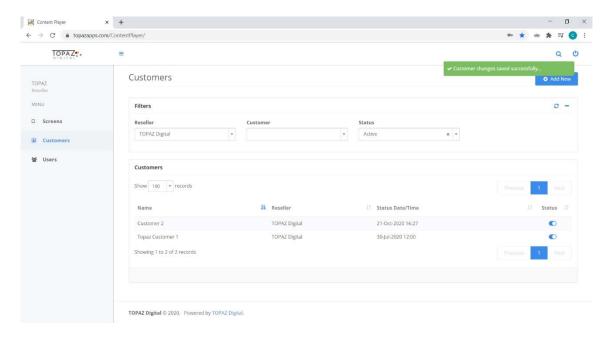




5. When 'Add New' is clicked you will be taken to the 'Add New Customer' screen. Simply type the name of the customer (Customer 2 in this example) and click 'Save'



6. You will now see this appear in your list of Customers.





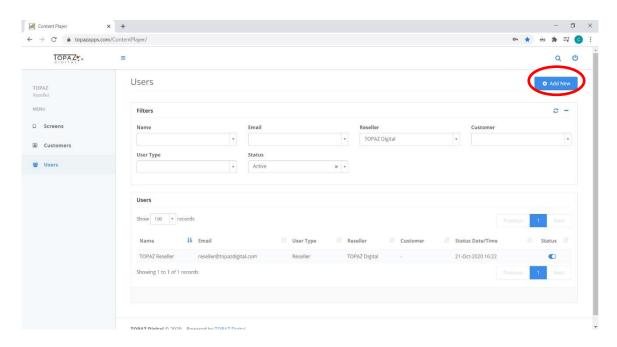
#### **Creating and Managing Users**

7. Once you have created a User Organization, you can then create User Accounts which will enable your customer to log in and manage their own accounts.

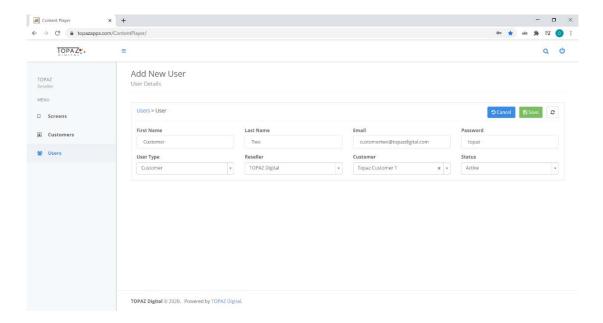
To do this, click on 'Users' on the left side menu.

Here you will see a list of all Users registered under your 'Reseller' account (this includes your own log in).

Click on a User Name to manage and edit it, or click 'Add New' to create a new User.

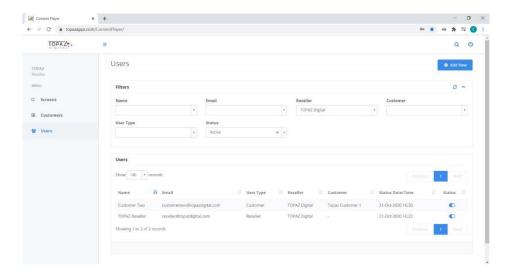


- 8. On the 'Add New User' screen, you will see the following fields that must be filled in:
  - First name
  - Last Name
  - Email (used for user to log in)
  - Password
  - User type (Only customer can be selected)
  - Reseller (Only your Reseller Account can be selected)
  - Customer (select from here which customer Organization you would like this assigned to)
  - Status (keep as active)



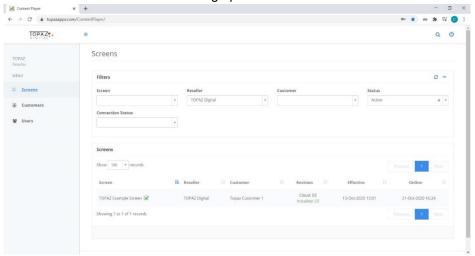


9. Click Save and you will now see the new User in the 'Users' screen.

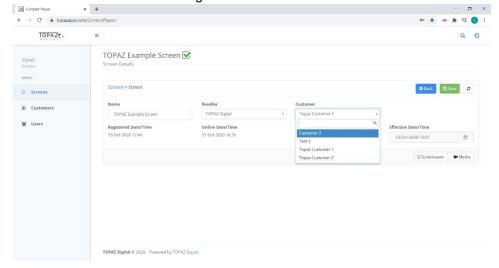


#### **Managing and Assigning Screens**

10. When screens have been assigned to your reseller account by TOPAZ, you will see them in the 'Screens' section. Click on the screen to bring up it's information.



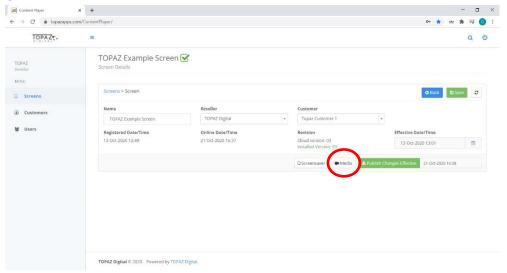

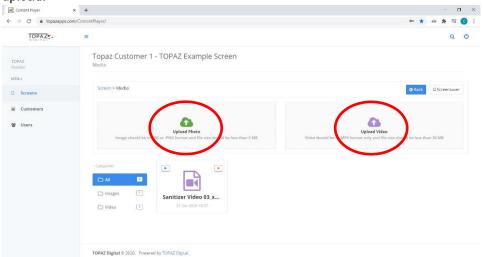

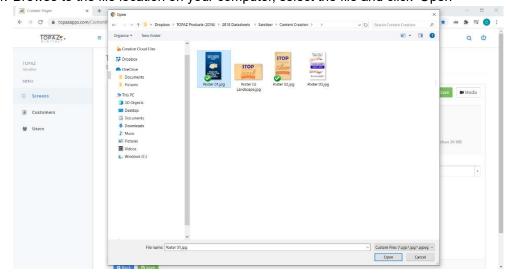
12. Click on the screen and select the 'Media' icon.



13. Click the 'Upload Photo' or 'Upload Video' button depending on what type of content you want to upload.

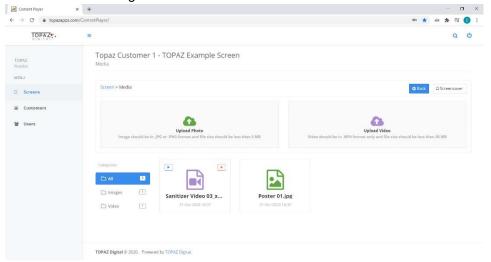


14. Browse to the file location on your computer, select the file and click 'Open'

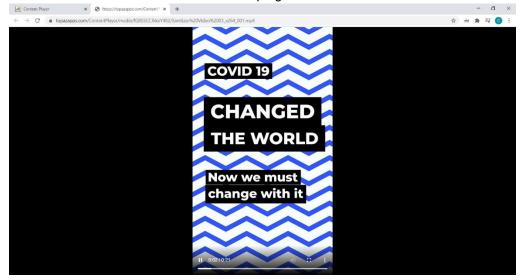

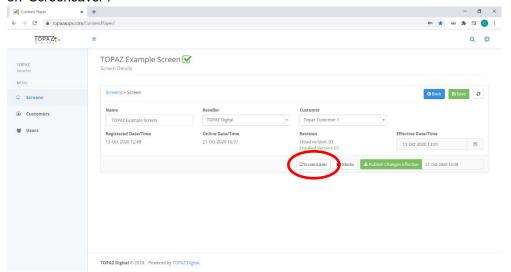

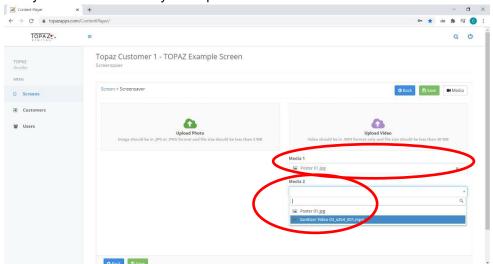


#### **Assigning Content to a Screen**

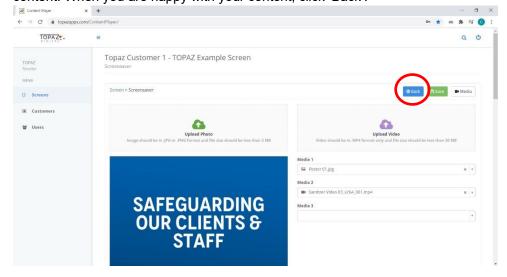
17. Once content has been uploaded and is available to a Customer, click on a Screen and then click on 'Screensaver'.

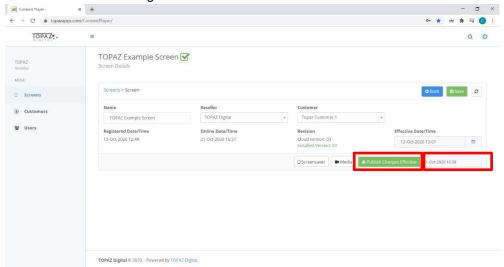
19. Once you have clicked Save, a preview of your content will be visible. Scroll down to see all content. When you are happy with your content, click 'Back'.



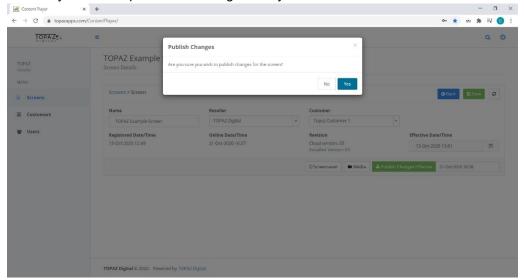


20. You are now able to Publish your changes. To do this immediately, simply click 'Publish Changes Effective'.

15. Once content has been uploaded and is available, click on a Screen and then click on 'Screensaver'.

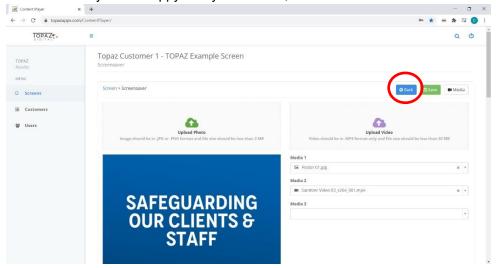

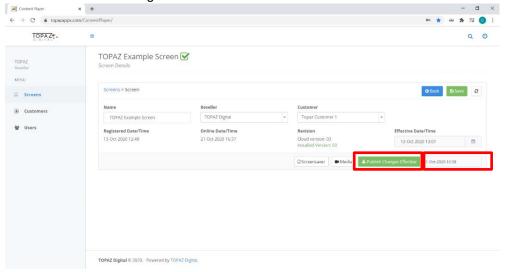
